Senator Brock: Citizens Can Claim Money Owed to Them By the State

Senator Brock is pleased to announce that he has received from the Unclaimed Property Program a list of citizens in Davie and Rowan Counties who are owed money by the State. The program currently has \$500 million in their possession, with nearly \$2.5 million belonging to citizens of the district.

The money they have comes from financial institutions, insurance companies, business and government agencies in the form of wages, utility deposits, and insurance proceeds, to name just a few of the 100 different types of property the program collects. By law, entities in possession of unclaimed property must turn over what they have to the Unclaimed Property Program. That money is then made available

to the public.

“Two Constituents are owed over \$30,000!” Senator Brock said. “Citizens of Davie and Rowan Counties should be aware that the State currently has hundreds, sometimes thousands, of their dollars and I’m happy to do what I can to help them get it back.”

To that end, Senator Brock is publicizing a list of all people in the 34th district who have money waiting for them in Unclaimed Property Program. The list is included in this newsletter.
